While we are working on your EAP application, we recommend you contact your utility company. They may be willing to give you an extension to give you more time to make payment. You can also ask if the utility company will set up a payment plan to break down the amount you owe into smaller payments that you can pay over time. We also recommend contacting other resources in your community.
