

Utility Crisis: Steps You Can Take

Crawford County

Is your household experiencing an energy emergency? Have you received a disconnect notice? Is your propane or fuel oil getting low? Here are the steps you should take:

1. Complete an application for the Energy Assistance Program including all required documents. Please remember, EAP cannot make a pledge until we have a complete application.
2. Contact your utility company. They may be willing to give you an extension that will give you more time. Ask if the utility company will set up a payment plan for the amount you owe. This will break down the amount you owe into smaller payments that you can pay over time.
3. Look for other resources in your community, such as the Township Trustees or area churches/charities. Call 211 to find other available resources.
