# Utility Crisis: Steps You Can Take Harrison County

Is your household experiencing an energy emergency? Have you received a disconnect notice? Is your propane, wood, or fuel oil getting low? Here are the steps you should take:

- 1. Complete an application for the Energy Assistance Program including all required documents. Please remember, EAP cannot make a pledge until we have a complete application.
- 2. Contact your utility company. They may be willing to give you an extension that will give you more time. Ask if the utility company will set up a payment plan for the amount you owe. This will break down the amount you owe into smaller payments that you can pay over time.
- 3. Look for other resources in your community, such as the Township Trustees and other resources listed below. Call 211 to find other available resources.
