



SENIOR FARMERS' MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM

The Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) is available in Crawford and Perry Counties, under the sponsorship of Lincoln Hills Development Corporation through the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP). Participants must be at least 60 years of age or be a disabled person age 55-59 who resides in a housing complex for the elderly/disabled that is served by a congregate meal service. If eligible, you will receive a check booklet worth \$20 that may be used through October 16, 2021, at vendor markets who accept SFMNP vouchers. Due to limited funding, this program is offered on a first come, first serve basis.
